I got my Ipad last week and I haven't been able to put it down. Let's start with the shape of the Ipad. It is very like the ipod touch so most of you will be familiar with the design. One difference is that it's BIGGER. Much bigger. The front is glass and the back is just aluminium. When you turn it on you will see the same display as on an ipod touch or an iphone. When you first get it you will have the standard apps. Mail, notes, calendar, mail, safari, photos, ipod, the app store and the itunes store. The first time you open the app store you will be asked if you want to download your free version of ibooks. Which sadly doesn't come as standard. The iPad is very light although some people have been complaining that it's too heavy. It feels really nice to hold which is why I constantly find myself taking it out of the case. The display is very bright and the touch screen is very responsive.



CONS: Less apps, more expensive apps, not compatible with older macs, takes a long time to charge, does not support flash, very locked down.

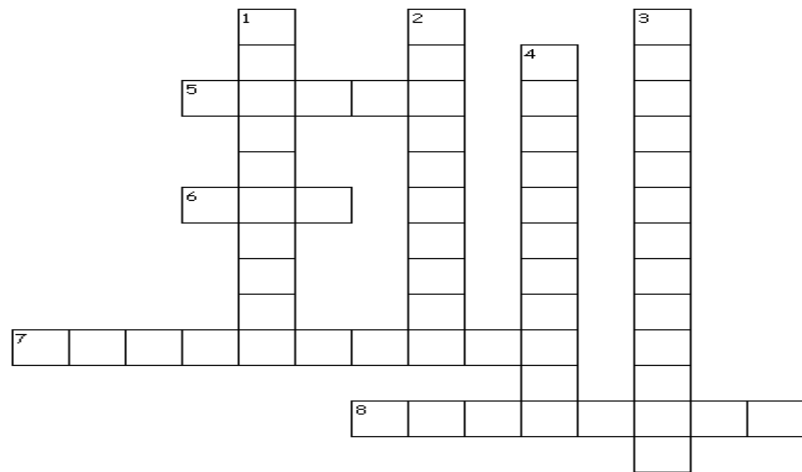
